



JOINT POSITION STATEMENT THE OAXACA LETTER


PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO CONSTRUCTION WORKERS IMPACTED BY HURRICANE KATRINA

Whereas, the construction associations of the North American Construction Federation convey their deep concern about the suffering of the victims of natural disasters and similar emergency situations, the loss in human lives, the destruction of property and the mass displacement of populations that results from them in the coasts of the Gulf of Mexico, particularly in the states of Alabama, Louisiana and Mississippi, we agree to the following:

- The importance of providing humanitarian assistance to construction workers harmed by natural disasters and similar emergency situations;
- To encourage their respective governments to provide humanitarian assistance to victims of such disasters;
- To establish an emergency working group in order to, at the appropriate time, facilitate and provide support in the recovery and reconstruction of the areas affected by Hurricane Katrina.
